The European Civil Aviation Conference (ECAC), as the implementing body of the European Union-funded CASE II Project, together with the Arab Civil Aviation Organization (ACAO), the African Civil Aviation Commission (AFCAC), have the honour of inviting your representatives to the Third interregional seminar on "Innovation and Cybersecurity" which will be held in Casablanca (Morocco) from 17 to 19 July 2024.

The main objectives of this seminar are to:

- review existing risks and mitigation measures in relation to cyber security;
- review industry practices in managing cyber risks to their operations and assets;
- discuss the impact of innovation on aviation security; and
- review recent innovative solutions in the field of aviation security.

Simultaneous English-Arabic-French interpretation will be provided during the presentations and discussions.

- return flights to/from Casablanca (Morocco) for maximum two participants per State. In order to facilitate the booking of flights, nominees are requested to provide full details in the attached nomination form and to provide a copy of their passport bio-page.
- A per diem to the eligible two participants which will be paid to participants after the event, travelling from outside Morocco for this purpose, the exact amount of which will be individually specified to the participants prior to the seminar. The per diem are intended to cover food, accommodation, communication costs, local transportation, and other sundry expenses during the mission. Participants are responsible for determining its usage for themselves.
